

Pinwheels at Night Quilt Layout

Fabric 1 - black

Fabric 2 - light with polka dots


Fabric 3 - assorted brights

Fabric 4 - black with polka dots


To make each pinwheel block:

1. Place Piece B-1 on top of Piece B-2, right sides together; draw a line diagonally across the square. Stitch along both sides of the


line (Fig. 2), and then cut along the line (Fig. 3). Open the two resulting squares and press (Fig. 4). The finished squares should be 2½"; if not, square them up with a ruler. Using the same fabric, repeat this step to create a total of four B units (half-square triangles) for each block.



- 2. Use the same method as in Step 1 for Pieces C-1 and C-2 to create a total of four C units (half-square triangles) for each block.
- 3. Place Piece E-2 over the left side of Piece E-1, right sides together. Stitch across Piece E-2 on the diagonal (Fig. 5). Cut away the resulting outside triangle (Fig. 6) until it is ¼" from the seam; open the E-2/E-1 unit, and press.



4. Place Piece E-3 over the right side of the E-2/E-1 unit (Fig. 7) and use the same method as in Step 3 to complete a double half-square triangle (Fig. 8). Repeat Steps 3 and 4 to create a total of four E units (double half-square triangles) for each block.



5. Sew together a finished E unit and Piece D, stitching along the long edge of the large triangle (E-1). Open the sewn unit and press the seam toward Piece D. Repeat this step to create a total of four D/E units for each block.
