

Donna Kooler's Crocheted Afghans Corrections

Zigzag Baby Afghan, pg. 22

Special stitch used:

Ch 4 = simple popcorn

Rep Rows 5-26 until you have 202 rows. End with 5 rows of sc. (207 rows total.)

The ch 4 creates the simple popcorn because you don't skip any sc before or after the ch 4. The ch 4 creates the bump between 2 sc. Looking at the completed afghan with row 1 at the bottom and row 207 at the top, the photo on page 22 is actually the top right corner of the afghan.

Pink Square Afghan, pg. 30

Special stitch used:

Ch 4 = simple popcorn

Use size N for small rectangles, squares, and large rectangles

Rainbow Blocks Afghan, pg. 62

Carnival Afghan, pg. 68

Add to the end of Rnd 5 after (9 dc per side.) Turn square and work remaining rounds on wrong side.

Aran Afghan, pg. 78

FPdtr2tog around 2nd and 3rd FPdtr: Wrap yarn around hook three times insert hook from the front around 2nd FPdtr, yarn over and work off two loops three times leaving two loops on hook then wrap yarn around hook three times insert hook from the front around 3rd FPdtr, yarn over and work off two loops five times.

DOUBLE DIAMOND PATTERN:

Note: All FPdtrs are worked around stitches 2 rows below.

Skip dc in the row below when making an FPdtr or FPdtr cluster.

INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 20.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc across. Turn – 21 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc, BPdc, 15 dcs, BPdc, dc, dc in tch. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc, FPdc, 2 dcs, FPdtr around 8th st 2 rows below, 2 dcs, FPdtr around 11th st 2 rows below, dc, trcCL, dc, FPdtr back around 11th st 2 rows below again, 2 dcs, FPdtr around 14th st 2 rows below, 2 dcs, FPdc, dc, dc in tch. Turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc, BPdc, 15 dcs, BPdc, dc, dc in tch. Turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc, FPdc, 4 dcs, FPdtr around 1st FPdtr, 2 dcs, FPdtr2tog around 2nd and 3rd FPdtr, 2 dcs, FPdtr around 4th FPdtr, 4 dcs, FPdc, dc, dc in tch. Turn.

Row 6: Ch 3, dc, BPdc, 15 dcs, BPdc, dc, dc in tch. Turn.

Row 7: Ch 3, dc, FPdc, 2 dcs, FPdtr around 1st FPdtr, 2 dcs, FPdtr around 2nd FPdtr, dc, trcCL, dc, FPdtr around 2nd FPdtr again, 2 dcs, FPdtr around 3rd FPdtr, 2 dcs, FPdc, dc, dc in tch.

Repeat rows 4 – 7 until there are 33 diamonds. End with row 5 – 133 rows.

Small square joined on two sides: Join black with sc in any sp between 3-dc groups, (ch 3, sc) in same sp, ch 3, sc next sp, ch 3, (sc, ch 1, sc in corner of adjoining square, ch 1, sc) in next sp, [ch 1, sc in next sp of adjoining square, ch 1, sc in next sp, ch 1, sc in next sp of adjoining square, **ch 1**, (sc, ch 1, sc in next corner of adjoining square, ch 1, sc) in next sp] twice, ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3, end sl st to join in beg sc.

MORE DETAILED EXPLANATION OF JOINING, PAGE 96

JOINING

Side 1 and Side 2 refers to working on opposite sides of the foundation chain. Each strip tells you whether your first row starts on a RS or a WS. When it says Sides 1 and 2 are the same, they both start on the same side (RS or WS). On Strip 3, Side 1 starts with the WS facing, Side 2 starts with the RS facing.

You complete Side 1 in its entirety before you go on to Side 2. So if you are told to turn, turn at the end of a row as you normally would until all rows are completed for that side, then fasten off. Begin Side 2 on the other side of the foundation chain and work back and forth, turning at the end of each row.

Here is the sequence for joining the 13 strips.

1. Strip 1 color D
2. Strip 2
3. Strip 1 color A
4. Strip 3
5. Strip 1 color C
6. Strip 4 (color C to the outside, color D to the inside)
7. Strip 1 color B
8. Strip 4 (color D to the inside, color C to the outside)
9. Strip 1 color C
10. Strip 3
11. Strip 1 color A
12. Strip 2
13. Strip 1 color D
